

Short bio of Speaker

Rajesh Jha is a Professor and Graduate Chair of Animal Sciences at the University of Hawaii at Manoa, USA. He graduated with a Veterinary Medicine degree from Tribhuvan University, Nepal, and an M.Sc. in Poultry Nutrition from Wageningen University, the Netherlands, with minor thesis research conducted at Massey University, New Zealand. He obtained his Ph.D. from the University of Saskatchewan, Canada, and worked as Research Associate at the University of Alberta, Canada, before joining his current position at the University of Hawaii in 2012.

Prof. Jha's research is focused on evaluating novel feedstuffs and feed additives for their nutritional and functional value to develop feeding strategies and modulate the gut health of monogastric animals using *in ovo*, *in vitro*, and *in vivo* models. He has [published](#) over 200 papers in different forms, including over 90 peer-reviewed articles. Also, he is a highly active [presenter](#) in national and international meetings and serves as a Visiting Professor in Germany, Japan, Korea, China, and Nepal. He also serves on the editorial board of several high-impact academic journals, including Section Editor of Poultry Science.
