Kidd has bachelor's and master's degrees from the University of Arkansas in poultry science. His doctorate is from North Carolina State University. Kidd became research manager and then director at Nutri-Quest, Inc., in St. Louis, Missouri, then he joined the Mississippi State University faculty in 1999 and headed the poultry science department there from 2007 to 2010. He joined the University of Arkansas in January 2010 to head the poultry science department and direct the Center of Excellence for Poultry Science, and towards the end of 2019 he returned to faculty with the position as professor, and in 2020, he was named holder of the Adisseo Endowed Professorship in Global Sustainable Poultry Nutrition. He is a Fellow of the Poultry Science Association and served as the Poultry Science Association president in 2012 and 2013.
